

Sample Schedule

The Katz Professional MBA program is designed to meet the busy demands of working professionals. Students have the flexibility to complete the program at their own pace. Classes are offered in the morning, afternoon, and in the evening from 6:20 to 9 p.m. Some courses are also offered on Saturdays. In addition, a select number of courses are offered in a blended online format that minimizes time spent on campus.

Below is a sample path for admitted students who intend to follow a three-year plan. These students typically register for 18 credits per year. Fourteen-week courses are worth three credits, while seven-week courses are worth 1.5 credits.

Year Three

* From 1 to 8.9 credits, students are charged per-credit. From 9 to 15 credits, students are charged a flat fee. At over 15 credits, students are charged the flat fee, plus per credit for credits over 15.
