## Overview


Students are entitled to (1) license of the Parallels Virtual Machine application. Staff do not have this option as of 4/6/2020.



Click on “Parallels for Students, then click on the blue “Download” button.








# Downloading Parallels

Click the actual disk image for download of “ParallelsDesktop-15.1.3-47255.dmg” (as of 4/6/2020).  
Download and install the application.



Click on the blue “Claim Key(s)” button to show your installation license key.




# Downloading Parallels

Downloading the Parallels VM application from [software.pitt.edu](https://software.pitt.edu)

Follow the prompts for installing Parallels and enter the product key. Once complete there will be an option to install Windows 10 during the initial startup of Parallels.



Click on Parallels icon in the menu bar and select **New > Get Windows 10 from Microsoft > Download Windows 10**



From Installation Assistant you can select **Get Windows 10 from Microsoft**. The install file will download and once complete you will need to enter a license key for Windows 10. This can be obtained from [Azure Dev Tools for Teaching](https://azure.microsoft.com/en-us/develop/devtools/).
