Eligibility Rules and Deadlines

- All participants must be undergraduate or graduate university students at either the University of Pittsburgh or other local invited universities and enrolled at least part-time during the term in which the Symposium takes place (Spring 2022).
- Posters can be authored individually, or in teams of up to three individuals. (Award money will be divided equally among the total of presenters on each team.)
- If all authors are undergraduates, then the poster will be entered in the undergraduate judging pool; otherwise, the poster will be entered in the graduate judging pool.
- Authors must register their intent to create a poster by the **Registration deadline: March 1, 2022**. Authors that register and submit a poster will receive

Free attendance for the Friday, March 25th Virtual SCM Symposium.
- Students must register as a poster presenter by emailing Janice Trygar at jmtrygar@katz.pitt.edu. Space is limited so register early!

Please provide the following information in your registration email to jmt141@pitt.edu

- A list of authors (First and Last names) and corresponding email addresses for each team member. (If you are a solo presenter, please indicate this as well in your message.) Please include the named authors affiliation (university, major and undergraduate/graduate status). This list can be updated or changed up until the **Abstract submission deadline, Monday, March 1, 2022**.
- Contact email and phone numbers for the primary author are required. Contact information for other authors is recommended.
- Topic of interest. This can be updated or changed up until the Abstract Deadline.
 - Note: Topics may be rejected by the Center for SCM if they are deemed to not be relevant to Supply Chain Management. Also, if a single topic is oversubscribed, then authors may be asked by the Center for SCM to select another topic, so please register early.
- The final poster abstract should be submitted by the **Poster title and abstract submission deadline, Monday, March 1, 2022**.
- At least one member of each team must be present to answer questions on Thursday evening. Participants who cannot attend Round 2 because they classes will be excused. However, they should let Janice Trygar know about their absence by March 18th. Winners will forfeit their prize if they are not present at the Thursday, March 24th awards ceremony.
